Australian Photographic Society Approved Exhibitions

The exhibitions tabled on the rear of this page are APS approved National and International Exhibitions for Prints, Slides, Projected Image, Digital and Audio Visual. The most recent details can be found via the APS website: <http://www.a-p-s.org.au> and in Australian Photography Magazine.

This list has been confined to those exhibitions held within Australia only, however there are many international exhibitions held in other countries, which may also be entered. This list is intended as an approximate timetable and last known contact guide only and thus it should not be assumed that the details and APS approvals are accurate for 2007 unless 2007 dates are quoted.

Many of these exhibitions don't finalise details and print entry forms until a several months prior to the exhibition. As a result it is not possible to produce a full year calendar of these events. The list provided here shows all the exhibitions currently held together with their most recent contact details and approximate dates. Where a particular date for 2007 has been written in for both the closing date and exhibition dates of an exhibition, the details will be accurate for the year 2007 and the entry forms may be already available. Highlighted exhibitions are yet to release their 2007 details.

- As accurate details for each of these exhibitions become available the information can be sought from:
 - People who enter and are on the mailing list
 - The list published in "Australian Photography Magazine"
 - The APS Website - <http://www.a-p-s.org.au>
 - The last known contact for the exhibition, ie the person listed on this table. In many instances the contact person remains the same for a number of years. Alternatively this person can usually pass you on to any new contact where this has been changed.
- Entry forms may be obtained by either:
 - Writing to the exhibition
 - Emailing the contact person for the exhibition
 - Downloading the form from the exhibition website where available
- Entry forms will often be sent to you automatically if:
 - You have entered the same exhibition the previous year
 - You are an APS member. Some forms (but not all) are distributed with the "Image" magazine that APS members receive.

Exhibition Circuits

A number of the exhibitions coordinate their exhibitions such that they will automatically forward your entry to the next exhibition in that particular circuit at your request. Entry forms and fees are sometimes sent together to the first exhibition in the circuit or alternatively you may be required to obtain and send the applicable form and fees to each one to meet the images that have been forwarded.

The circuits are very economical to enter as the cost of transporting the entries between the events is borne by the exhibition leaving the entrant with the cost of postage to the first exhibition and back home from the last only.

Note:

If you believe that at any point in the future you may consider applying for APS Honours (Acceptances at the National and International exhibitions count towards honours recognition) then it is crucial that you keep your catalogue from each exhibition in which you receive any acceptances. It is the catalogues that verify your results.

It is also important that you retain a copy of the entry form showing the exhibition APS approval number until you have your catalogue and have checked that this approval number is shown in the catalogue. You will need this number for any honours applications.

Whilst you need to have been an APS member for at least a year to apply for your honours, acceptance points gained prior to membership are still valid. There is also no time limit during which the points must be obtained, ie. they can be gathered over many years.
